CREATION OF MAN

The above mentioned is one of the passages which many people find difficult to understand, or which they refuse to accept.

The common explanation on the creation of man is, that by conception is submitted a certain number of chromosomes. Together they constitute the complete "blueprints" to the new man. It is the chromosomes that decides the number of fingers, hair colour, eye colour and so on. These chromosomes are coming partly from the father and partly from the mother. In a way that explanation is quite well, only it doesn't explain anything.

In the first stage the new individual must be a single tiny cell, without any likeness to any human being, but with a content of "blueprints", that is, the chromosomes. Let us first suppose that there isn't any kind of intelligent knowledge about the construction of a body present in that cell - neither the intelligence from the father, from the mother nor from outside. What, then, should make this little cell grow to a man? Just a lot of blueprints cannot alone - without any assistance from an intelligence - become a finished model. "Something" must make the "machine" - my readers, I beg your pardon, but in this case the mother is nothing but a machine working, furnishing the right materials and the building site - must make the machine tick. So "something" must make the machine deliver the right elements in the right place. If no intelligence was present, as we assumed, legs might be placed on top of the head, the kidneys where the brain should be and the eyes placed right deep in the abdomen. We might also experience a heart consisting of horn and the eyeball clothed with hair. No, there must be an intelligence present who - based on the blueprints, the chromosomes, - places everything at the right place in the right order. This intelligence cannot be that of the mother, as she is not conscious of any creative work made by herself. And it is certainly not that of the father, - but who else or what else can it be?

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Theoretically we could imagine that it was the intelligence which we know is inside every and each cell, but what, then, is this intelligence? Where does it come from, and from where is the knowledge coming? Again we have come no step further.

The explanation put forward by Adamski is by far the most logic you can find, as anybody who does a little thinking about existence doesn't escape the idea of the Creator, whether you call the Creator God, Cosmic Intelligence or something quite different. Anybody reflecting on existence will sooner or later accept the existence of the Creator. Notice the astronauts - the american ones, anyway - they are all deeply religious, or they have become so little by little. Also great scientists come finally to this Creator in their philosophical and scientific valuations. We, too, have long ago reached the same point of view: THERE IS A CREATOR. This Creator is a kind of intelligence lying far beyond our apprehension, but it must simply be this creative intelligence that is the intelligence behind that wonder called creation of a new human being.

This Creator doesn't make any mistake, he puts the elements correctly together and at the right place. And if something is going wrong it always turns out to be caused by man. The cause may be different poisons which spoilt the "blueprints" or the building elements, or the parents may have delivered wrecked "blueprints", or the cause may be inflicted from outside, e.g. by shock, blow or the like.

If you begin to view things in this way you will by and by discover more and more proofs that it must be so. This Cosmic Creative Intelligence is working in all of us, from conception till death. - That we do not conform to that intelligence but act according to the dictatorship exercised by our senses, is quite another story. This intelligence is inside all of us, in our mind, our consciousness - in and around us, and it must be in all creation, living as well as "dead" matters. - So it's up to us to perceive this intelligence and act with it in complete harmony. When first we have perceived this truth we have made a big step along the road towards - knowing ourselves.

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THE INTELLIGENT CELLS.

Scientist discovers cell-consciousness.

All cells have a consciousness and a memory bank. They can feel and correspond with each other. These are the conclusions reached by the American scientist Clive Backster after more than three years of research at Backster School of Lie Detection, and of course his discoveries have raised a great attention.

Backster who is a well-known expert on lie detectors made his discovery by accident as he was to control how long it took a plant to suck water from a pot by the aid of a lie detector.

A lie detector consists of two electrodes which are fastened on the experimental object. If this object is a human being the electrodes are placed on both sides of a finger, and a small electric current is sent between the electrodes. When a man reacts emotionally he will build up a resistance to the current, and this is then recorded graphically.

Backster fastened the two electrodes on the top leaf of the plant and thought that he in that way would be able to measure how long it would take the water to get up there. Water is a good conductor of electricity, so the resistance should be reduced as soon as the water reached the leaf. But when Backster studied the graph he became surprised as the resistance had INCREASED, and the pattern on the graph showed distinctly an EMOTIONAL REACTION.

He understood that this absolutely had to be examined. He carried out various experiments, and the results were incredible. The plant expressed a strong reaction when he thought of hurting it with a match. Yes, that's the way it was. Already as Backster THOUGHT this hostile thought the plant gave a reaction, and the graph showed beyond any doubt that the plant had read his thoughts.

Yet the plants did not only react when they were exposed themselves, they also reacted in sympathy with other life forms. If Backster smashed a fecundated egg or hurted another living being this was reflected in

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the detector. To get further proof Backster placed three plants equipped with electrodes in three separate rooms. In the fourth room he had a machine slipping living worms into boiling water at various intervals. This machine had a bell time recording device. In the evening he started this machine and the lie detectors, and the next morning he could compare the recorded times with the graphs. In each case the readings corresponded EXACTLY.

At another experiment he let six men one by one pass through a room with two flower pots. One of these men were to "murder" one of the plants. Afterwards he slipped the lie detector on the "witness" left behind. As the six men one by one passed through the room again the "Witness" exposed the murderer.

It is not just plants that have these emotional reactions, as experiments carried out with fungi, amoeba, fruits and blood gave the same results. For instance human sperma have "pointed out" the father in the same way as the flower witness pointed out the murderer.

Clive Backster stated his findings in the International Journal of Parapsychology, february issue 1969, and the case is now studied at several universities in the US.

That all cells have consciousness, memory bank, knowing and can communicate with each other is just WHAT ADAMSKI SAID.

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THE HEART OF GOD

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ceive what the kernel of corn would bring forth of itself; but this kernel begins to manifest from the Innermost Self, from the Heart, the Center of that kernel and so it comes forth like a stalk, and then many kernels. When this Heart begins to act in this way, - It brings itself forth, bit by bit, into expression.

It is the same with everything. Where does the bird get his song from? The song comes from the Innermost Self and not from the surface, and it does not worry about how it shall be conveyed or expressed. It just sings and that is all. It is the same with plant life. Unless we get down to basic laws, the truths of things, we shall not free ourselves from disastrous conditions which lack of understanding has brought upon us - even the possible annihilation of this civilization by an atom bomb. It has all been brought about through misunderstanding. Man doesn't want to annihilate himself,

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even the Devil knows better than that! If he annihilated his Hell, he wouldn't have anything to govern. We can lay all the troubles that are in the world today to our religious institutions, regardless of what they are. Because you and I are working many hours a day, and we don't find time to get into the Book (Bible) and study, we appoint or accept some man who is supposed to understand these things, so that on Sunday he may give us some of the truths, as few as he knows. Instead he perpetuates himself, or his livelihood, and gives us many times only a lot of political nonsense. We are facing oppression by religion more than by government.

How many of us know we ARE the truth. We seek truth out there, somewhere, when in reality WE ARE THE TRUTH! How many of us really KNOW ourselves for what we are? Most of us know ourselves for the same things everybody else knows. First, we recognize a human because he has eyes. For instance, he can look patient, irritated, or otherwise, and by his eyes we can tell in what state of mind he is. Second, because he can hear and can talk and tell us what he heard. Third, because he can smell the same things we can. Fourth, because he tastes and eats. These are the four predominant expressions in the world by which man is known as Man. If he did not have them we might call him another creature - but never a Man. So it is by these four avenues of expression, the four senses, that Man became a man.

Yet what are they? I am going to prove to you that we are fooling ourselves, and this is the evidence. With today's developments (high frequencies) I can sensitize the floor of a room to the degree that if a fly was to land on it, it would reproduce a noise like a thunderstorm. Let's seat one thousand people in this room - two thousand eyes! Now I'll project a three dimensional form that you recognize as a human form to walk across the center of that floor. All eyes will see it, and all thousand pair will agree that a form is going across that floor, but the ears which are supposed to hear will disagree saying, "If anybody went across that floor we would have heard him, especially since the floor is so sensitive." So there's a fight between the senses. On the other hand, if I passed a sound across the floor of someone walking, the ears would say, "We heard someone go across the floor." But the eyes would say, "No, we would have seen someone!" Here we have two predominant senses in the human make-up that can't agree with each other. The other senses will often

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falls short of Jesus' teachings. We have good institutions to some degree. There is nothing so bad but what there is not some good in it. There is not an organization in this world that doesn't do some good. But when we want Truth, actual absolute Truth, we must search deep for it. This is represented by the 12-pointed star. Man has always been represented by the 5-pointed star, the five senses, although I mentioned only four. He also has, as medical science knows, senses or central points from the base of the spine to the top of the body known as nerve centers. In the Bible they are known as seven churches or seven spirits, and in Hindustini they are known as Chakras. There are three below the Solar Plexus which represent the earthly manifestation and control the limbs and generative organs. Then there are three upper ones which control the heart, the soul, and the spirit. BUT they all receive their power from the one we call the Solar Plexus. The Solar Plexus is symbolical to the sun in our solar system. So there are seven all together, and with the other five, you have twelve.

Now, there is a dominating force above these twelve which is a Universal Force which might be considered a Christ. Call it what you will because names don't mean anything. the word "Christ" has actually been derived from Universal Consciousness and means a portion of Divine Consciousness, that's all. A very small portion of it is a single light. That is why Jesus said, "I feed you with milk and not with meat for you are babes in Christ." Jesus on the Cross is really the thirteenth character. He was the thirteenth member of the group that included the twelve disciples. The twelve disciples symbolize these twelve centers. Yet there is even more to know even than this. Above the head of the Trinity in the Catholic Church, you will see twenty-four cupids (or angels). In the Budhistic teachings you will find the same representation in symbology - a statue with twelve arms on each side. In the Protestant doctrine you hear of twenty-four elders around the throne of God. They all mean the same thing.

However, as teachers we stop at the twelve. We perpetuate the Christ, we teach the Christ to that limitation; but we do not go any further. Why? Because we are afraid that if we go further we might have to give up material pleasures which we call living. For example, there were 72 apostles who went out to preach the Gospel and left their

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oppose each other in the same way. Now, how in the world do you expect to have respect for another fellow being when your own characters of which you are made up have no respect for one another? They must LEARN to respect and have faith in each other first - then and then only can you hope to rise to the mastery of self and truly know yourself. This is our true right which was granted to us the day of our birth. The only time a man can play a heavenly melody on the four strings of a violin is when they are all tuned in relationship to each other - not opposing one another. This is true also of the senses. Here is something that has not been taught to our people even in the highest teachings as they are called.

You have read that at one time or another Jesus was confronted by a character called Satan, and that Satan offered Jesus all the wealth of the world which he had to offer. Jesus did not say anything but listened to him as the offers were made. When Satan had no more to offer, Jesus did not condemn him for the offering. Satan had done the best he could. After all he offered all he had, what else could he do? But Jesus realizing this said, "Look, Satan, follow me. I'm not following you. You have come to a limit and I know the passway of NO LIMIT." He didn't condemn Satan for the offer, He told him to follow Him. Even Satan could attain greater riches than what he offered to Jesus, if he would but follow Jesus. Herein lies the difficulty: We have teachers, good ones, but how can a man teach anything but what he himself knows? And since man's faith falls far short of Jesus' faith, his teachings also

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families at home with plenty. They returned after several months to find their families were poor - all the food gone, etc. They complained that God hadn't taken care of their families while they were out serving Him, and they didn't want to continue. The twelve disciples in this case are representatives of the earthly phase - but when you attain the other part which is the spiritual part, you will balance.
